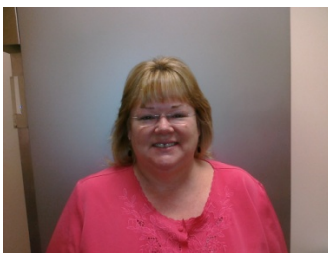

President's Corner



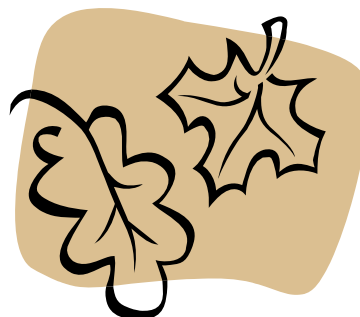

Hospital entrance is on the left.

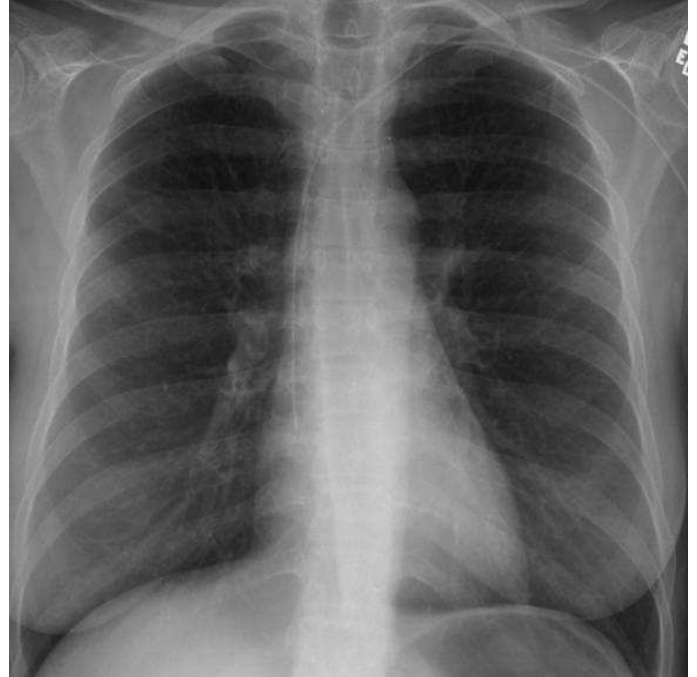
From New Haven via 95 South:
